COUNCIL NOTES

It is hard to believe that "Summer 2019" is almost over. In spite of the rain, and sometimes with the assistance and encouragement of neighbors, everyone made a special effort to keep your yards looking neat and cheery.

The rain has made construction projects difficult to complete. Any roadwork projects may be delayed until 2020, unless we get a dry autumn, otherwise the road base will not be dry enough to build on.

The **regional water main construction** through the Village is nearing is completed in town.

The next scheduled Council meeting is September 16, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.



PLEASE RESTRICT YOUR WATER USE between: September 16th to 18th, and September 23rd to 25th.

WHY? A temporary shutdown of the water transmission line crossing road construction at Ft. Saskatchewan is occurring. This line is the main supply line that provides our water.

Municipal reservoirs will be filled prior to the shutdown; however, all non-essential water usage must be restricted to avoid running out of water in our reservoirs.

All bulk water truck fill stations will be shut down during the above dates, and we ask that all residents restrict non-essential water use during these periods.

WAYS TO PAY YOUR TAXES AND UTILITIES

- 1. Cash either at the Village Office or the ATB agency;
- **2. Pay by cheque** by mail, at the ATB agency, or in person at the Village Office;
- 3. Electronic Fund Transfer through your bank ... if you bank with ATB, CIBC, Scotia Bank, TD, or Credit Union. Unfortunately, after September 30th you will not be able to pay your accounts through RBC by EFT as they charge prohibitive fees. No other bank charges us these fees.
- We also accept payments by e-transfer at <u>vilna@mcsnet.ca</u>
 PLEASE ENSURE YOU SAY WHAT ACCOUNT YOU ARE
 PAYING.
- **5. Another alternative** is to make arrangements for us to automatically withdraw funds from your bank through the Electronic Fund Transfer program.

CRIME IN VILNA ...

Unfortunately, as with many smaller towns and villages like Vilna, businesses and residents are being victimized by acts of crime, whether it be trespassing, violence, vandalism, breakins, theft, graffiti, or misdemeanors.

When we are vigilant and report offences, we can reduce ruthless criminal activity. **Doing nothing does nothing**!!

The Provincial Justice Minister has been travelling Alberta, speaking and listening to citizens about crime and justice.

Some actions the province is taking are review of parole conditions, criminal code amendments and adding at least 50 prosecutors to the judicial system.

The RCMP ask that anyone who witnesses an offence and/or suspicious activity to **REPORT! REPORT! REPORT!**

If possible – Pictures, videos and notes about time and dates, descriptions of physical appearance or activity are very important in assisting the police make law and justice effective. Each time you call they create a file and use compiled information to charge offenders.

Crime – an act prohibited by law, especially against morality.

Theft – taking something that belongs to someone else without his or her explicit consent.

Trespass – entering another person's property without permission of the owner; causing damage and/or for criminal intent.

Vandalism – destruction of someone else's property. If you damage public or private property on purpose, you have committed the crime of vandalism.

Graffiti –graffiti is the damage to property caused by: spraying, writing, drawing, marking or applying paint or another marking substance to a person's property without their consent.

New in Town?

PLEASE READ YOUR WATER METER at the end of each month and phone the reading to the Village Office 780-636-3620 & leave a message. Then, you only pay for water you use not an inflated estimate. Thank you.

Garbage and Recycle (cardboard, metals, compost (separated)) pickup is on Wednesdays - Items for pickup must be out for 8am. If you miss garbage day, the Vilna Transfer Station (dump) is west about a mile west on the north village boundary road #594. Open Tuesday and Saturday 9am to 5pm.

DOGS <u>must be LICENSED by the Village AND on a</u> <u>LEASH</u> off your property. Clean up after your pet!! <u>FINES APPLY!!</u>

If you have or are starting a business you require a business license – \$10 at the Village office.

PLEASE ensure you maintain your yard (summer) and sidewalks (winter) – whether you rent or own.

RENOVATIONS, CONSTRUCTION, DEMOLITION OR **REPLACEMENTS**

If you are considering renovating your home, building on your lot, demolishing a building or replacing your hot water tank or furnace, keep in mind that most of these activities require a PERMIT. These are legislated by the Alberta Safety Code and are mandatory when requirements are met. Most of the time, your plumber, gasfitter, or contractor will apply for permits on your behalf, but it's your responsibility to ensure that this is done. Building, Plumbing, Electrical and Gas Permits can be accessed by visiting the office or going to the Village website at: http://www.vilna.ca/document/library/836/category/2303/Forms-and-Permits/.

The forms are not fillable, so need to be printed and sent to the Inspections Group with the permit fee. YOU MUST ALSO APPLY TO THE VILLAGE FOR A DEVELOPMENT PERMIT. The development permit and other forms are online as well. Check at the Village office or with The Inspections Group 780-454-5048 for the amount of required fees. Some sheds, decks and fences may also require a permit. If you have questions, give us a call.

Turn north on RR105 and follow it as it curves and turns into Township Road 593. The road curves again and 593 turns into RR110. In about 800 metres, you'll see where the trail crosses the road. Abilene Junction is to your right (east) and just down the trail a few metres.
