Administration's report was presented to Council including:

- Of the 12 properties on shut-off notification 10 have paid or made arrangements. 2 have been notified of a pending water shut off.
- The lagoon will be released again before November 15, 2019. The natural form of desludging of the lagoon is very satisfactory, along with the restriction of trucks using the lagoon for dumping the lagoon is much healthier.
- The Disaster Recovery Program project paperwork is in progress.
- Administration attended the September 24 AUMA CAO supper session in Edmonton. In addition to some valuable networking, there was also a session regarding environmental changes and the work that can be done to reduce impact.
- Still no word from inquiries to FCM regarding the release of our \$50,000.00 (Sept 4, 2019 finalized by FCM). A further inquiry was emailed to FCM on October 10.
- No further progress has been made regarding properties placed on the March 31, 2019 tax recovery listing at Alberta Land Titles. Registrations of Tax Notifications have been completed by land titles and letters from the registrar sent out. The Village will be sending similar notifications to each owner. Currently there are 3 properties potentially on the auction sale list in April 2020. There is also one property that was on an agreement to pay who has deserted their agreement. This property will have to be sold.
- The campground contractor has wrapped things up at the campground and Public Works has pulled the dock and done some road work.
- Public works has been preparing for winter equipment and pothole patching.
- The garbage truck compressor for the air brake system has failed, a part ordered and the old compressor removed. We just await the new part Cost \$500.00 + core fee.
- Public works has been asked to isolate some cc valves which has been done, fortunately without any broken valves.
- The purge shredding was completed and declaration for same finalized.
- We have received an offer of \$5,000.00 for the sale of the old grader.
