#### **COUNCIL NOTES**

- The Smoky Lake County Region in conjunction with the Primary Care Network has purchased Cardiac Testing Equipment that has been set up at the Primary Care Centre in Smoky Lake. The equipment includes A Defibrillator with pacing package and an Electrocardiogram machine
- On June 30<sup>th</sup>, Councillor Roy Dyck resigned from Council.
- The Vilna School is 100 years old this year and the Village of Vilna will be 100 years old in 2023. To commemorate the two centennials a volunteer committee has begun celebration plans. The formal celebration will take place during the Boom Town Days Celebration on 2022. For a lasting commemoration a Centennial Park is being developed at the Park Reserve on the south side of the Seniors Lodge. Volunteers will be needed to assist in the Park Development as well as the Celebration.

The RCMP would like to remind everyone to take precautions to protect themselves from being victims of property crime.

Remember to lock your vehicles. Keeping door locked goes a long way toward staying safe. Turn on exterior lights in the evening and leaving them on through the night also deters crime.

- Is your front door locked?
- Are your tools put away?
- Is your dirt bike put away?
- Are your windows locked?
- Are your bikes put away?
- Are your vehicle's windows shut?
- Did you remove the keys from your vehicle?
- Are your outside lights on?

The RCMP encourages the public to report any criminal or suspicious activity. As more records are created, they will get a better picture of our community and the problems that might be brewing. Those reports tell RCMP where to look, who to look for, and where to patrol in the future.

- UNTIL WE GET RAIN back yard bon fires are <u>prohibited</u>
- Vilna Fire Department will not be issuing any burn permits. ... Barbeques will be allowed but must be supervised to ensure that they do not cause a secondary fire.
- UNTIL WE GET RAIN, please be conscious of the amount of water being used. With the extreme heat it is becoming difficult to keep the reservoirs full and the dry conditions are creating a higher demand for firefighting.

#### **COVID-19 UPDATE**

July 1st, 2021 - Premier's message: The Alberta's Open for Summer Plan safely eased restrictions in 3 stages as vaccination targets were reached and hospitalizations declined. Alberta entered Stage 3 on July 1. All public health measures have now been lifted except for isolation/quarantine requirements and masking requirements in health care settings and public transit.

Mask use in public indoor settings is no longer required except for some specific situations: working in or visiting any continuing care facility, as well as any facility operated by AHS, Covenant or their contracted service providers

using public transit, including ride share vehicles, taxis, motor coaches and shuttles

Note: Municipalities and businesses are free to set masking requirements as they see fit. <u>For</u> <u>example, businesses may require staff and/or</u> <u>customers to wear masks inside their place of</u> <u>business.</u>

While masking is no longer required in most situations, it is important to support those who may wish to continue wearing masks while adjusting to Stage 3.

#### COVID VACCINATION STATISTICS:

Although Premier Kenny is bragging that as of July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 73.1% of Alberta's population is vaccinated, be AWARE that in Smoky Lake County Region only 52.4% of the population has been vaccinated and in St. Paul County only 40.7% are vaccinated.
