The Village of Vilna Community Standards

Bylaw sets out guidelines respecting the following matters:

- The safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property;
- Nuisances, including noise and unsightly properties; and
- Clearing of all snow, ice, dirt and other obstructions from the sidewalks situated on land adjoining the property owned or occupied by them.

The following sections of the Bylaw identifies Property Owner or Occupiers responsibilities.

4.1 Owners are responsible for all activities on their property.

5. Property Maintenance

- 5.2 A person shall not cause or permit a nuisance or unsightly condition to exist on property they own or occupy.
- 5.3.1 Excessive accumulation of materials Building materials Appliances
 - Household goods and boxes
- Tires and vehicle parts whether of apparent value or not.
- 5.3.2 Loose litter, garbage, garden or lawn waste, animal feces.
- 5.3.3 Unkempt grass or weeds
- 5.3.6 Trees, shrubs or other vegetation that interferes with any public work or utility, obstructs sidewalks or roadways adjacent to property, or impairs visibility for safe traffic flow at intersection.
- 5.3.7 Failure to keep property in a <u>reasonable</u> state of repair:
 - Significant deterioration or structures fences or improvements;
 - Broken windows, doors, siding, steps, railings, shingles etc.
 - <u>Significant</u> fading, chipping, pealing, rotting or absence of paint on buildings or fences;
 - Conditions that may create a danger to public safety.

16. Addressing

16.1 The owner of a Property on which a Building has been erected shall display the civic address number assigned to the Property at a location plainly visible from the roadway in front of the property.

New in Town?

- Garbage and Recycle (cardboard, metals, compost (separated)) pickup is on <u>Wednesdays</u> Items for pickup should be out for 8am.
- *If you have a dog,* you require a license (\$10/year per dog at the Village office
- If you have or are starting a business, you require a business license – \$10 at the Village office.
- **PLEASE** ensure you maintain your yard (summer) and sidewalks (winter)
- Vilna Transfer Station (dump) is west about a mile on the north village boundary road #594. It accepts household garbage, cardboard, garden waste, trees/trimmings, unpainted untreated wood, some household hazardous waste containers, batteries, tires etc. NO Building materials permitted.

Fire Rating: Fire Ban and Off Highway Vehicle Restriction

UPDATED: April 30, 2024

The Fire Ban and OHV Restriction **remain in effect** for Village of Vilna and Smoky Lake County. Fire Crews have responded to wildfires 25 out of the 30 days in April. Though rain received throughout the region has helped reduce the risk of wildfire, <u>the Fire Ban and OHV</u> <u>restriction will remain in effect until vegetation turns</u> <u>green</u> and fuel loads reduce significantly.
